**THREAT ANALYSIS**

Recent briefs have reported on the threat chemical spills pose to the healthcare sector. While it is important to have a chemical spill response plan, it is equally important to have a decontamination plan that details how you will take care of staff that might become contaminated with one or more chemicals.

**ACTION STEP**

***Ensure you have plan in place for decontaminating staff***

[1] Determine your strategy for decontaminating staff in the event of a spill. Do you have trained personnel and appropriate equipment available, or will you require assistance from outside resources?
