A new study by the Collective Giving Research Group and supported by the Women's Philanthropy Institute explores giving circle hosting. Here's what it found:

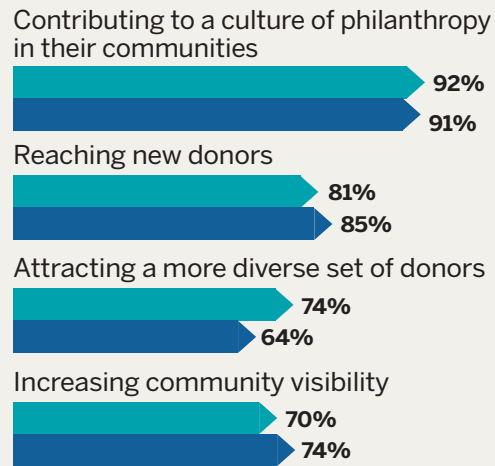
