Women's funds share the broad goal of **advancing women's philanthropy**; their specific objectives, and the ways in which they pursue them, vary widely. Top objectives of women's funds:







Women's funds have been most successful at having an impact by achieving short-term goals through empowerment and community-based change.

Social change is the opportunity for people to be as successful and happy and healthy as they would like to be in our community.

Many women's funds pursue their organizational goals through grantmaking and **go beyond grantmaking to achieve impact**.

Women's funds demonstrate intersectionality by incorporating **different lenses and voices** in their pursuit of goals and impact. Women of color are working a lot of part-time jobs, sometimes two and three, and not getting any benefits...
They are working themselves to the bones. We wanted to see that end.
