NATIONAL TERRORISM ADVISORY SYSTEM - No Active Alerts

THREAT ANALYSIS

U.S. Special Operation Forces recovered what is thought to be the handwritten journal of Usama bin Ladin. Examination of the contents reveals that the al-Qa’ida leader advocated attacks on smaller U.S. cities. His plans called for spreading out attacks, as opposed to a focused assault on one high-profile target, with the objective of inflicting thousands of casualties. Although **there are no current specific credible threats to the homeland**, it is possible that these plans could have been communicated to international or domestic terrorist groups.

ACTION STEPS

Terrorists could plan attacks against any city

- [1] Stay alert for suspicious behavior, such as: loitering; actual or attempted entry into restricted areas; pre-attack surveillance with cameras, blueprint requests, asking specific questions about security procedures; unattended bags, etc.
- [2] Review your facility’s emergency lockdown and evacuation/shelter-in-place plans.
- [3] If you see something, say something!

INDY EVENTS

The following events have an expected attendance of at least 500 people. Mass gatherings are of concern to the healthcare sector for multiple reasons, including being potential mass casualty incidents as the result of natural or man-made hazards, and also provide venues for transmission of communicable diseases.
