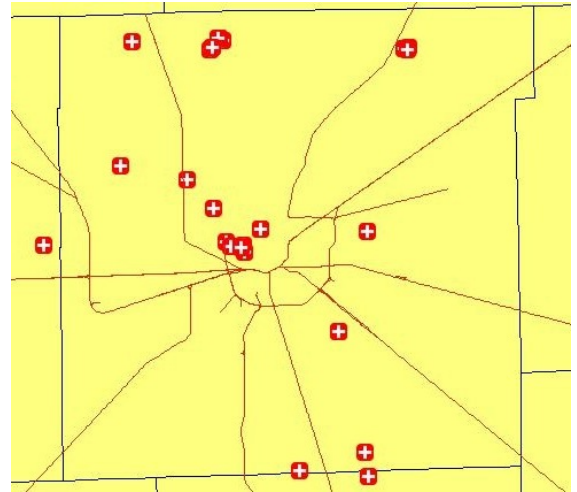

THREAT ANALYSIS

The May 10th brief discussed several incidents of suspicious packages being left next to railways. Now, tampering with a railway has occurred in Iowa in an attempt to derail a train carrying a large quantity of flammable liquids. Had the train derailed, a significant and long-lasting fire, resulting in possible injuries and deaths, could have occurred. The map to the right, created by MESH, shows the location of hospitals and railways in Marion County.



ACTION STEPS

Derailed trains are a threat to the community, and to the healthcare sector

- [1]** Determine the proximity of rail systems to your facility. The initial evacuation distance for a rail tank car containing flammable liquid is ½ mile.
- [2]** Review shelter-in-place and evacuation plans.
- [3]** Encourage staff that observe any suspicious activity around railways to notify law enforcement.

Mass gatherings are of concern to the healthcare sector for multiple reasons, including being potential mass casualty incidents as the result of natural or man-made hazards, and also provide venues for transmission of communicable diseases.
