


## CHARITABLE GIVING AROUND THE 2016 ELECTION: Does Gender Matter?

Politics and charitable giving used to be seen as two separate worlds. But the relationship between the two grew much closer in the aftermath of the 2016 election, when a number of progressive 501c3 charities anecdotally reported fundraising increases.

This study is the first to examine this trend through a gender lens, and suggests the growing relationship between charitable giving and politics—also known as "rage giving"—is driven by women, who are using their financial assets to make their voices heard and express values around elections.
